**"Discover Bradley" Website Project:** *Shortly after the successful Sicily campaign, Supreme Allied Commander General Dwight Eisenhower instructed war correspondent Ernie Pyle to "go discover Bradley." The result was a series of articles in Life Magazine. Pyle wrote of Bradley's strong commitment and care for his soldiers, nicknaming him the "Soldier's General," which made Bradley immensely popular on the home front. At present, General Bradley's legacy is not adequately showcased in American culture. There is no online source that serves as the official hub of Bradley's legacy. Like Ernie Pyle's newspaper and magazine articles, the "Discover Bradley" website project aims to re-introduce General Bradley using today's media.*
